2.	e-COVID-19 LIVING MAP OF RECOMMENDATIONS	20 min
	 a. Discuss feedback, methodology, and overall next steps Limitation of the e-COVID-19 living map is lack of comprehensiveness and inclusion of other high-quality guidelines (such as those published in MAGIC) Potential solution: Include the main resources and a link to other existing resources (that may not meet a minimum quality threshold) in order to make them available, and allows the inclusion of guidelines that may not be high quality or are conflicting with other guidelines Living map to be available as a resource for guidance developers on the COVID-END website, however, to include some text that outlines some areas of improvement and development to make the living map more representative and comprehensive International Database of GRADE Guideline (BIGG) database was raised as an example of a comprehensive database that includes all guidelines, despite the quality, and the decision and evaluation of the quality is left to the discretion of the end user Provides the possibility for others to evaluate and map out what was produced at some point and have some indicators to see if the recommendation that was produced at the time was supported by the evidence or not, and that is made possible due to access to all guidelines
